Please make 1 sided copies of your paperwork

- 1. National HSRA Membership Application. Download both forms in your National profile.**
If you were a member last year you have a profile. Do **not** create a new one.
If you were in JH (8th) and going into HS (9th), use the same profile. Do **not** create a new one.
If you are **new** this year, then you need to create a profile at: <https://nhsra.equestevent.com/login>
(Membership application & Minor's Release - 2 pages).
 - Student signature - both pages, Membership application & Minor's Release NOTORIZED
 - BOTH Parents/Guardians signatures - both pages, Membership application & Minor's Release NOTORIZED
 - If one parent is deceased, or if one parent has sole legal custody, you must indicate so on the signature lines.
- 2. Wisconsin Rodeo Student Membership & Permissions Form.**
 - Signature of Student
 - Signature of student, parent, witness on Permissions (photography, ground rules, and responsibility agreement)
- 3. Grade and Conduct Report**
 - **Signature of School Superintendent, Principal, or their designee.**
 - Include copy of most recent **grade transcript (end of 4th quarter) & age verification** (often found on grade report).
In the spring 3rd quarter, grades will need to be turned in.
- 4. Emergency Treatment & Medical Release**
 - Signature of **BOTH** parent(s)/Guardians NOTORIZED
- 5. Wisconsin Rodeo Contestant Bio Form** to be used by announcer.

 - Make 1 check to WHSRA. Do NOT write a separate check to the National Association.

Ground Rules

These rules are presented through the authority and responsibility granted to State Charter Associations by the National High School Rodeo Association. All decisions will be made based on these published ground rules and the current NHSRA Rule Book.

MEMBERSHIP/ENTRY & CHECK IN DEADLINES

Membership deadlines: Your paperwork must be uploaded to your national membership profile, along with and money, emergency release, and contestant bio postmarked 9 days prior to each entry deadline. If a membership application is postmarked after the deadline, applicant will NOT be eligible for correlating rodeo.

Eligible members must: **ENTER ON LINE at www.whsra.org if problems arise-** email the rodeo secretary prior to the deadline secretary@whsra.org. **A confirmation receipt of entry should be received by the contestant via email PRINT THIS OFF AND BRING WITH YOU TO RODEO IN CASE OF DISCREPANCY.** IF an amendment is needed, the contestant must notify the secretary VIA email secretary@whsra.org and receive confirmation of the change. Entry link can be found on the website www.whsra.org Further instructions and miscellaneous rodeo schedules can be found on the website www.whsra.org.

THREE CALLS TO COMPETE: Contestants will receive 3(three) verbal calls by the announcer to compete in their event. The announcer will be instructed by the Arena Director to state the following:

Contestant name

Contestant name and “this is your SECOND call”

Contestant name and “this is your THIRD and FINAL call”

Failure to compete when called upon results in contestant disqualification from **THAT EVENT for that go of the rodeo.**

At State Finals: the top 20 (twenty) accumulative point leaders in all events(excluding Queen & Shooting events) are required to confirm their intent to participate in the short go BY THE DESIGNATED TIME DEADLINE with the rodeo secretary at the secretary’s office. Failure to comply will result in ineligibility for the short go and the next person will be eligible to roll up.

SCORING AND PENALTIES

PARTNERS: Both members of a team roping “team” must be properly entered (naming one another as partners) “Single” team ropers will be accepted (limit of 4 times per contestant).

PARTNERS: In the team roping and ribbon roping, if your partner visual or medical releases another partner is allowed to be drawn. With the exception in a 2 go rodeo, and the 1st run in that event has been completed by the team. A 2 go rodeo consists for a reverse draw.

DISMISSAL: An Arena Director may decide to excuse/dismiss a contestant during a run after breaking the pattern. At the Judge’s discretion, any contestant will be notified of his/her “final” 30(thirty) seconds to start his/her run/ride. Not following the Judge’s directive results in a NO Time.

LOCATION (HOSTING RODEO COMMITTEE) Rules

DRESS CODE: Full western attire must be worn during the rodeo in the arena and designated area set by each rodeo committee. Back tags must be worn 1 hour before first performance or slack, and must be visible when the contestant enters the arena.

SPEED LIMIT: All vehicles in forward or backward motion must remain UNDER the 5(five) mile per hour speed limit on the rodeo grounds.

PARADES: All contestants will participate as outlined by the Rodeo Committee in any parade scheduled in the contestant information packet.

CURFEW: Any dances will end NO LATER than 12:30 a.m. to abide by the established curfew or 1 a.m. for all contestants (both on and off the grounds).

GROUND CONDITIONS: Student event directors are the contestant representatives who speak to the arena directors. Local host committees and arena directors will include student event directors in making decisions when conditions warrant major changes.

JUNIOR HIGH DIVISION

TIME LIMIT TO COMPETE: Tie-Down Roping, Boys Break away, Girls Break away, Boys Goat Tying, Girls Goat Tying, Team Roping, Ribbon Roping – Optional one (1) minute time limit will be used at regional rodeos (except Chute Dogging is always 30 sec). Steer Saddle Bronc and Steer Bare Back Riding will be 6 seconds to obtain a score, and for Bull Riding 8 seconds to obtain a score.

Thirty (30) second time limit will be used during the short go at State Finals Rodeo for all timed events.

REMINDERS:

Required horse health papers

Proof of negative Coggins Test, Interstate Health Certificate, Premises Code Number, etc.

As published on rodeo information sheets, each location has specific required horse health papers. Travel with original DVM issued documents and COPIES must be turned in at time of arrival on Rodeo Grounds (at entrance gate) - \$1 per page will be charged to make copies. Please include appropriate livestock premises code – additional information available at www.datcp.state.wi.us/premsises/index.jsp

RULE BOOK PUBLICATION:To save printing costs, the NHSRA Rule Book will be published bi-annually. The current publication is available online at www.nhsra.com.

2018-2019 WHSRA Responsibility Agreement

As a Wisconsin High School Rodeo Association member it is my responsibility to meet the following obligations. If any WHSRA member or parent has any questions about the member responsibilities please feel free to contact your state president, national director, state secretary, student advisor, or a WHSRA board member.

Please read the following agreement below and sign and turn in with your membership packet prior to being eligible to compete.

Members must:

1. A contestant that qualifies for Nationals **AND** has completed the MANDATORY fundraisers will receive all amenities that are associated with the mandatory fundraisers.
 - a. Any contestant whether they qualify for Nationals or not and **DID NOT** complete the mandatory fundraisers will **NOT** be eligible for any amenities that are associated with the monies received from the mandatory fundraisers for the current year.
 - b. Fundraising money is used for Saddles, Buckles, Awards, Jackets, Shirts, Scholarships, monetary gifts, so by signing the agreement you are aware that if you choose not to fund raise then you forfeit your eligibility to receive these benefits.
2. Participate in Rodeo Grand Entries by volunteering to be a flag carrier for our national and local sponsors, saying the Cowboy Prayer, or singing the National Anthem. If you are not a Flag carrier, you will participate in the Contestant Grand Entry unless you are a Rough Stock rider or 1st, 2nd or 3rd in the 1st Event.

Highly Recommended: Acquire 1- \$100 Year End Sponsorship(s) or equivalent to. (Can be 4 at \$25).

Remember these items are recognized during scholarship application reviews for your Senior Year Scholarships.
